Health care for the uninsured

Welcome

At Henry Ford Macomb Hospitals, our mission to provide Macomb County residents with the best possible health care requires us to extend services well beyond the walls of our hospitals. Our ultimate goal is to keep people healthy. To do that, we invest in our own community benefit programs and partner with other community-based organizations to expand and maintain health care access for all residents, including the uninsured. Our Neighbors Caring for Neighbors clinics are one way we extend our care.

Clinic Services

The clinics provide free office visits and health education to people of all ages.

- Treatment for acute illnesses, such as colds, ear infections, bronchitis, or rashes
- Treatment for chronic illnesses, such as high blood pressure and diabetes (plus free glucometers and assistance with test strip costs)
- Employment and school physicals
- Referrals to the Henry Ford Macomb Prescription Resource Network to obtain free or low-cost medications
- Referral to other services

Diagnostic testing, such as lab or radiology work, is not provided at the clinic. However, the clinic provides prescriptions for tests in addition to helping connect clients with financial assistance resources through Henry Ford Macomb Hospitals. The organization's Financial Support Program includes a 40 percent discount on necessary hospital-based services for uninsured patients. Patients may qualify for further discounts, based upon income guidelines.

Clinic Locations and Hours

Appointments for clinic services are required. Clients who have an urgent health care need should call the clinic to determine whether an immediate appointment is available.

In order to receive services, you must:

- Be a Macomb county resident or be an established patient of a Henry Ford Macomb Hospitals medical staff member
- Have a household income of less than \$30,000
- Have no health insurance
