Immunization Form
2018 – 2019

- Wayne State University (WSU) requires that your immunization records be on file at the Campus Health Center (CHC) before you move into your residence hall room.
- WSU STRONGLY recommends that students come to school fully immunized to protect their health and the health of the WSU community. Immunizations are one of the most effective public health measures in preventing certain communicable diseases.

When is the deadline to return the form?

Please return the completed form with a copy of your immunization records *at least* 14 days before move-in day.

How do I submit my immunizations to the Campus Health Center?

*You may also fax the form and your immunization records to (313) 577-9581 as long as the records are legible.

*Late records may be submitted on move in day.

How can I find my immunization records?

Contact your health care provider, or your local health department to request a copy of your immunization record. If you are Michigan-born, your immunization record should be on file with the Michigan Care Improvement Registry (MCIR). Contact your most recent health care provider or your local health department to check for your MCIR records.

Does CHC give immunizations? Are there fees for immunizations?

Immunizations are available at CHC, and you may schedule an appointment to receive them. It is recommended that students get all immunizations before arrival on campus to ensure they are adequately protected when they arrive. Call **(313) 577-5041** or visit health.wayne.edu for more information on pricing and accepted insurance plans.

Students under 18 years old need written parental consent to receive immunizations.

If you are not 18 on or before move-in day, please have your parent or guardian complete an Enrollment Form (available at <http://health.wayne.edu/forms/>) and submit it with your vaccine record or bring it to your vaccine appointment.

How can I find out if I've had all the recommended immunizations?

Ask your health care provider to review your records, determine your needs (immunity against many (but not all) of the diseases listed below can be determined through blood tests) and provide recommended immunizations. You may also make an appointment with one of the CHC providers to review your immunizations and provide any necessary immunizations. Which immunizations are recommended for college students?

- Chicken pox (Varicella) if you haven't had the disease already (2 doses)
- Hepatitis A (2 doses)
- Hepatitis B (3 doses)
- Human Papilloma Virus (HPV) for both males and females through age 26 (3 doses)
- Measles, Mumps and Rubella (MMR - 2 doses)
- Meningitis B vaccine (MenB) – consider ages 16-23 (2 or 3 doses based on brand given)
- Meningitis vaccine(MCV4) - Highly recommended for all incoming first-year students living in residence halls (2nd dose for booster starting at age 16)
- Tetanus-Diphtheria-Pertussis (Tdap – 1 dose)
